APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a, 23, 27 and 35 of the Arms Act.

It is a case of assault upon the informant due to which he sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that specific allegation of assault by means of



Dabia is against petitioner no.3 but the injury report is simple in nature and the allegation of shot fire to the injured, namely, Ajrarul is against co-accused Kalu. Petitioners have clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Katihar, District- Katihar in connection with Amdabad P.S. Case No. 249 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
