3 17-01-2022 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, through Video Conferencing.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Khanpur Police Station Case No. 172 of 2020, disclosing offences under Sections 363, 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the submissions of the parties, the petitioners are parents of the boy, who had kidnapped the victim, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Let the petitioners, named above, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within ten



weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate-IV, Samastipur, in connection with Khanpur Police Station Case No. 172 of 2020, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
