Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No.481 of 2020 registered for offences under Sections 304(B) and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Considering the post mortem report in which it has come that the deceased was killed by throttling her neck, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, who are



father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased. Prayer for
anticipatory bail is hereby rejected.
