APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30 (a) and 37(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is a case of recovery of one liter country made wine from the roof of the house of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that meager quantity has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and petitioner has not been apprehended at the spot. Petitioner has clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions as well as the fact that meager quantity of liquor has been recovered, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge, Excise, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Majhauriya P.S. Case No. 600 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
