Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Udwantnagar P.S. Case No. 65 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 414 & 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

The petitioner is a businessman and has a shop. One truck was found standing in front of the shop but there is no evidence to connect the petitioner with the ownership of the truck or the rice loaded in the said truck and there is no chance of his absconding.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Udwantnagar P.S. Case No. 65 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
