A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Rautara P.S. Case No. 96 of 2020 registered under Sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submission is that there is specific allegation against the co-accused person Vijay
