2 29-04-2022 Heard Mr. Prince Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. P.K. Verma, learned Additional Advocate General No.3 who represents the State through video conferencing in view of COVID-19.

The petitioner through this Criminal Writ Petition has sought quashing of the First Information Report bearing Patahi P.S. Case No.09/2021 registered under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code presently pending before the learned court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VIIIth, East Champaran.

From perusal of the FIR, it transpires that the



petitioner is the named accused and specific allegations have been made against him with regard to the killing of the informant's uncle, Krishna Murari Singh.
