learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 894 of 2017 registered under Section
498A of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite party no. 2 submit
that both the parties have settled their disputes by way of one
time settlement amount. Learned counsel for the petitioner
further submits that petitioner has already paid Rs. 20,67,000/-
to the opposite party no. 2. The opposite party no. 2 has already

received the aforesaid amount, photocopy of the draft enclosed in the supplementary affidavit, at 'Flag-A.'

In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Gaya in connection with Complaint Case No. 894 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
