2 14-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Banka

P.S. Case No. 706 of 2021, registered for the offences

punishable under Sections 341, 342, 323, 324, 307, 379

and 34 of the I.P.C.

As per allegation, petitioner along with his

associates assaulted the informant and his brother with

farsa, iron rod and bricks and stones. Further allegation is

that they also snatched the gold chain from the neck of the

informant.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the allegation against the petitioner is of assaulting the victim by iron rod but main allegation of assault by *farsa* is against the co-accused. He further submits that charge-sheet has been submitted against all the F.I.R. named accused including the petitioner. However, the charges have not been framed.

The petitioner is in custody since 27.12.2021.

It is also stated in paragraph no. 2 of the petition that the petitioner has moved earlier before this Court for grant of anticipatory bail vide Cr. Misc. No. 69145 of 2021.

It has further been stated that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

However, the learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000 /- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Purnea in connection with



Banka P.S. Case No. 706 of 2021, **after framing of charge**, on the following conditions:

(i) The petitioner will make himself available for interrogation by a police officer/court as and when required.

(ii) The petitioner will undertake that investigation/trial will not hamper on account of his absence or non-cooperation. He must be available to the police or the court whenever his presence is required.

(iii) The petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.

(iv) In case, it is brought to the notice of the court below that the petitioner has any criminal antecedent, the learned court below shall cancel the bail bond of the petitioner after hearing him and getting satisfied that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent despite his knowledge of the same.

(v) In case, it is brought to the notice of the court



below that statement regarding previous bail petition is wrong, the learned court below shall cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

The application stands disposed off, accordingly.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove all the defects pointed out by the office within a period of one month and the Registry is directed to issue the certified copy of this order only after removal of office objections.
