2 02-08-2022 As both these bail applications have cropped up from the same police station case number, hence, with consent of parties, they are being heard together and disposed of by this



common order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within four weeks. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 353, 427 & 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against these petitioners is that they created obstacle in discharging the official duty of police personnel by attacking upon them.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that no such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. Petitioners are only members of the mob which has created obstacle and attacked on the police party. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Ayar P.S. Case No.120 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
