learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 379, 307, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the F.I.R, It is a case of assault between the parties. Both the parties are own gotiya.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. There is

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposes the bail prayer of the petitioners.

Considering the facts and circumstance of the case as well as submission of the parties, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court Below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Danapur, Patna in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 536 of 2020 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C
