- order(s) for quashing notice dated 07.08.2017
(Annexure-P/4) under Section 7 of Bihar & Orissa
Public Demand Recovery Act against the Petitioner.
- (iii) For issuance of appropriate writ(s)/ direction(s)/
order(s) for quashing demand against the petitioner
vide Memo No. 791-1 dated 28.07.2017 for deposit of
Rs. 81.58 Lacs in the Nazarat within three days
failing which Certificate Case would be filed against
the petitioner; and also
- (iv) For issuance of a writ of Mandamus
directing/commanding the respondents to adjust the
vouchers which have already been deposited to the
concerned authority i.e. Respondent No. 7 and also
for a direction to the Respondents to receive the rest
of charges pending before the Petitioner.
