3 05-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Telhara P.S. Case No.36 of 2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 354, 379, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners are said to have assaulted the son of the informant by means of iron rod. The accused persons snatched a chain made of gold from the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the



petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail applications. There is case and counter case between the parties and both sides have sustained injuries. There is land dispute between the parties and both sides are agnates.

Taking into consideration the fact that the injuries are simple in nature, let petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Hilsa, Nalanda in connection with Telhara P.S. Case No.36 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
