4 11-04-2022 The learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to raise his grievances before the Divisional Commissioner, however he further submits that the plea of the petitioner to the effect that once the petitioner has been selected as a P.D.S. dealer by the District Selection Committee and license has been granted, the same can't be reviewed by the Committee so as to deny the petitioner, such license, be also



directed to be considered by the Divisional Commissioner.

In case, the petitioner files representation/ revision before the concerned Divisional Commissioner within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered on merits and disposed off, within a period of eight weeks, thereafter. The revisional authority shall also be obliged to examine the aforesaid issue raised by the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
