3 05-08-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through video-conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in a case registered u/s 302, 201 and 120B read
with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the F.I.R., the informant has alleged that his
younger brother Chandan Kumar was in love with Pinki Kumari
and on 18.11.2019 the informant got information on mobile that
his brother was going to Muzaffarpur to solemnize court
marriage with Pinki Kumari. It is further alleged that on
04.01.2020 the informant came to know that the petitioner and



co-accused persons under conspiracy kill his brother, Chandan Kumar and threw his dead body at Dhaupra Chaur. They also threatened to kill the informant and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated at para 3 of the bail petition. The other co-accused has already been granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench vide order dated 05.06.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 18782 of 2020. It is further submitted that the post-mortem report shows that the informant's brother died due to electrocution. There is no eye-witness in this case. The petitioner is in custody since 21.08.2021

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate 1st (West), Muzaffarpur, in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 10 of 2020.

The application stands allowed.
