The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No.101 of 2018 registered for offences under Sections 406, 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the reasons mentioned in the order 27.07.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. No.2899 of 2021 by which main accused Santosh Kumar has been granted anticipatory bail, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.



Accordingly, let petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri C.K. Verma, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Dehri-on-Sone, District Rohtas in connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No.101 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
