ORAL ORDER

5 11-08-2022 Though the present writ petition was filed for directing the District Sub-Registrar to register the sale deed pertaining to the land situated at mauza-Jokiyari, Circle-Raxaul, District-East Champaran having Thana No. 11, Khata No. 241 and Plot No. 611 bearing Jamabandi No. 729, however, during the interregnum period, the respondents have acted wisely and have taken a decision to unlock the plot in question from the restriction list of the computer of registration office, in a meeting dated 30.07.2022 of the District Level Committee, hence it has



been submitted by the learned counsel for the respondent-State that the petitioner has already been asked vide letter dated 04.08.2022 to complete the other formalities for the purposes of registration of the sale deed in question and get the same registered. It is also submitted that as soon as all the formalities are completed by the petitioners, the sale deed in question shall be registered immediately without any further delay.

In such view of the matter, nothing survives for adjudication, hence the present writ petition stands disposed off.
