ORAL ORDER

2 24-03-2022 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners prays to withdraw the application of Petitioner No. 1 as he has been arrested and the present application has become infructuous.

It is, thus, dismissed as withdrawn as having become infructuous as against petitioner No. 1.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Sheohar Mahila P. S. Case No. 39 of 2020 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 493, 376, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act.

The Petitioner No. 2 is the mother of the main accused



and she has no direct role in the crime alleged. Moreover, the matter has been settled between the parties.

The learned Advocate for the Opposite Party No. 2 has also appeared and submitted that the matter has been settled.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioner Nos. 2 & 3, above named, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/ (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar in connection with Sheohar Mahila P. S. Case No. 39 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
