3 22-03-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the email notice dated 27.1.2020 sent to the petitioner by which the candidature of the petitioner for grant of retail outlet dealership for the location No. 856 situated within 8 km. from Pipra Chowk on N.H. 106 has been cancelled.

Admittedly, now the retail outlet has been allotted to a third party.



We propose that the petitioner can now approach the Grievance Redressal Forum of the company.

Both the parties have got no objection to this.

Thus, we relegate the petitioner to the remedy of approaching the Grievance Redressal Forum of the Respondent-company, by filing appropriate petition within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be disposed of at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks.
