2 30-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 444 of 2018 registered under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a), 36, 38(ii) and 41(i) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submission is that the recovery of illicit liquor has been made from the commercial vehicle which is registered in the name of the petitioner, as is evident from Annexure-2. Petitioner has no criminal history.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Additional District Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Muzaffarpur in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 444 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
