“I. For rescheduling the loan amount and fixation of instalments for repayment and setting aside the process for auction sale of the mortgaged property for which letter dated 07.02.2022 has been issued by the authorized officer of the respondent Bank.

II. During the pendency of this



petition the proceeding under the SARFAESI Act may kindly be stayed.

III. For any other relief/reliefs which the petitioner entitled to in the facts and circumstances of the matter.”

In view of the fact that Debts Recovery Tribunal is now functional, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to such other appropriate remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
