ORAL ORDER

2 19-12-2022 The present writ has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1.That this is an application for issuance of a writ of mandamus any other appropriate writ/order/ or direction commanding Resp. No. 2 to submit enquiry report sought for by Resp. No. 1 upon complaint of Petitioner contained in Annexure '1' & '3' for punishing a City Superintendent of Police, an Assistant Superintendent of Police, a S.H.O. and a Sub-Inspector of Police by initiating departmental disciplinary proceeding against them for registering Rajeev Nagar P.S. Case No. 476 of 2019 in back date, for issuing wrong, illegal and ante-dated supervision note, special reports,



*progress report and writing ante-dated
fraudulent case diaries of said police case.”*

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law.

Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
