2      20-07-2022                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned  
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case  
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467,  
468, 471 and 120 (B) of the Indian Penal Code.

As per prosecution case, the petitioner secured job of  
Block Teacher on the strength of forged academic documents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. It is  
submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the marks  
sheet of the petitioner is defective since very beginning and it  
shows total marks 522 marks in numerals whereas the marks  
obtained in words shows it to be 418. Unfortunately, the



petitioner had not observed the said deficiency and anomaly earlier but when she came to know of the defect, she filed an application before the concerned Board on 04.12.2014 against which a receipt was issued in her favour. He further submits that now show cause notice was issued to the petitioner to explain her and she has not committed any irregularity intentionally.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions as well as the fact that petitioner is a lady, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Gopalganj in connection with Kataiya P.S. Case No. 250 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
