Petitioners apprehend their arrest in C-III-3 of 2009 registered under Section 47 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the recovery of alleged country made liquor and spirit has been made from the bathan, which is an open place.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a

period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Siwan in connection with C-III-3 of 2009 corresponding to Ext.Tr.No.3459 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
