because of COVID-19 pandemic restrictions.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is expected to
honour his undertaking to remove the defects as pointed out by
the office when called upon to do so by the office.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Gandhi Maidan P.S. Case no. 118 of 2020 instituted for the
offence under Sections 356 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case relates to snatching of mobile
phone of the informant by the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner



has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has got no criminal antecedent. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Specific allegation of snatching mobile set is against co-accused Pappu Sah. The name of the petitioner has been disclosed in this case by co-accused, namely, Pappy Sah, who was arrested on spot.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Gandhi Maidan P.S. Case no. 118 of 2020, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Judge-IV, Patna Civil Court, Patna subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
