2 15-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

80 liters country-made Mahua liquor has been recovered from the motorcycle of the petitioner.

It is submitted that though, petitioner is registered owner of the motorcycle in question, but at the relevant time, his motorcycle was being driven by one of his friend, who took his bike for purchasing medicine from the market and without knowledge or consent of petitioner, the same was being used for transporting the illicit liquor. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

However, learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently



opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that petitioner is registered owner of the motorcycle in question.

Considering the fact that recovery has been made from the motorcycle, of which, petitioner is registered owner, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner is rejected.
