Heard both the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioners seek bail in anticipation of their arrest in connection with Chandauti P.S. Case No.211 of 2020 instituted for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 308, 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Taking into consideration the nature of allegation and that there are cross cases with regard to the same incident for



which injuries have been caused to both the parties and the matter relates to division of property, I am inclined to grant benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioners and in the event of arrest, they shall be released on bail subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
