accused Suresh Das, Raj Kumar Das, Jagdish Das and Pappu Das caught hold of his nephew and Satyendra Das shot at him by pistol resulting into his death. They also looted away ornaments worth Rs. Three lac and cash.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Specific allegation of firing is against Satyendra Das and not against the petitioner. Only allegation of robbery is against the petitioner but the stolen articles have not been recovered from his house or from his conscious possession. There is case and counter case. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner no. 1 and 2 on bail. The petitioner nos. 1 and 2 are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Chandi P.S. Case no. 382 of 2020, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand) with two sureties of the

Hilsa, Nalanda subject to the conditions as laid down under
section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
