6 28-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Bath P.S. Case No. 28 of 2020 registered under Sections
498(A), 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the
Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further by filing supplementary
affidavit, he submits that petitioner is a poor person. His wife is
a nurse in a Private Hospital and earns handsome money. He is
ready to give Rs. 1000/- per month as maintenance to his baby

child. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.-XIII, Bhagalpur in connection with Bath P.S. Case No. 28 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
