2 17-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offence under Section 30(a) (d) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

29 liters of Mahua liquor has been recovered at Beldhar pain and petitioners are alleged to have fled away from the spot.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. Petitioners claim clean antecedent and are in custody since 11.02.2022. Investigation is complete.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



Considering the nature of allegation, clean antecedent and period of custody, the bail petition of petitioners is allowed. Let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Judge 1st Nawada in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 18 of 2022.
