2 23-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 307 & other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the F.I.R., on 26.03.2020 at about 8:00 AM, the petitioners alongwith co-accused Golu Kumar, armed with deadly weapons, came at the door of the informant and assaulted son and husband of informant, as a result of which, son of the informant sustained injury on his head and hands.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that there is case & counter case and both sides sustained injury. The injuries are simple in nature. Petitioners have got clean antecedent.



Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Jamui in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case No. 64 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
