This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Katoriya P.S. Case No. 111 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 324, 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the fact that because of trivial dispute the parties have entered into fight and also considering the fact that the injury sustained by the injured is simple in nature, this bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Banka, in connection with Katoriya P.S. Case No. 111 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
