learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Rajepur P.S. Case No. 168 of 2020 registered under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. Further he submits that from perusal of seizure list, it is apparent that the alleged foreign liquor has been recovered from the house of one Geeta Devi. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the

case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise Act, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Rajepur P.S. Case No. 168 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
