3 18-10-2022 Petitioner has prayer for following relief(s) : -

“For issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay remaining amount due to the petitioner worth Rs.4,46,371/- with 8 % interest since 04.12.2017 to till the date of payment followed by penalty and litigation cost as his father has deposited substantial amount under P.P.F. Scheme with Jhauganj Post Officer, Patna City, Patna or pass such other order/orders, direction/directions as your Lordships may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

On 17.10.2022, we had passed the following order:



“Despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner. However, in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.
