Petitioner has prayed for following relief(s) : -

“That this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of Public Interest Litigation for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding an directing the respondents authorities to give the voting right to the Ward Councilors of those Municipalities/Municipal Council and Municipal Corporation whose tenure has been expired as prescribed under sub clause 5 of Section 12 of the Bihar Municipal Act 2007 and its general election has not been held even after expiry of eight months in the coming election of Member of Legislative Council (elected by Local Bodies) by treating them as elected Ward



Councilors and/or may issue any other writ or writs, order or direction as may deem fit and proper by this Hon'ble Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that, in view of the intervening developments the petition has become infructuous and prays that the petition may be permitted to be withdrawn.

Prayer allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn as having become infructuous.
