Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Mohiuddinnagar P.S. Case No. 92/2021, registered for the offences under Sections 272, 273, 34 of the Indian Penal Code & Section 30(a), of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

The petitioner is a member of a gang of criminal, engaged in business of illicit liquor and the recovery is huge quantity.

In view of the fact that prima facie a case under the Excise Act, is made out against the petitioner, this application



for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable in view of Full Bench decision of this court rendered in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar reported in 2019 (2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)*.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed as not maintainable.
