2 11-08-2022 Heard the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to remove the defects within four weeks of resumption of normal court proceedings. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within stipulated period, office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 354, 379, 504, 506,34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the FIR named accused persons including the petitioners have assaulted the informant's side.



It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation leveled against the petitioners is general and omnibus in nature. In fact there was a free fight between the parties and in the alleged occurrence, both sides have sustained injuries. There is case and counter-case between the parties. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since there is case and counter-case between the parties, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Ghoghardiha P.S. Case No.29 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
