2 12-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 325 and 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assault upon the informant and her family members due to which they sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that there is case and counter case between the parties and both parties have sustained injuries, as alleged, in separate incident. Petitioner has clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Gopalganj in connection with Kateya P.S. Case No. 137 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
