the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Chapra Mufassil P.S. Case No. 403 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged in the first information report and they have been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing specific is alleged against them. The specific allegation is against co-accused Amit Kumar Singh and Suraj Kumar Singh. Petitioners have

no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, IX, Saran at Chapra in connection with Chapra Muffasil P.S. Case No. 403 of 2020 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
