2 10-03-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Kesariya P.S. Case No.370 of 2020 registered for offences under Sections 363, 366(A) and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the POCSO Act.

Considering the fact that the girl in her statement recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. has admitted that both the parties are major and have married in a temple and they are living as husband and wife, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.



Accordingly, let petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII - cum-Special Judge, POCSO, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Kesariya P.S. Case No.370 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
