2 10-03-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 have already been arrested and as such the anticipatory bail of petitioner nos. 1 and 2 has become infructuous. Accordingly, he seeks permission to withdraw the prayer of petitioner nos. 1 and 2.

It is, thus, dismissed as withdrawn as having become infructuous as against the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 .

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner no. 3 and learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner nos. 3 is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.



The petitioner no. 3 apprehends his arrest in connection with Jadia P.S. Case No. 81 of 2020 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 352, 353, 354, 283, 186, 188, 189, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the allegations against the petitioner no. 3 and also considering his age, he should be given one chance to become a good citizen. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application of petitioner no. 3 is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioner nos. 3 above named be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-Vth, Supaul in connection with Jadia P.S. Case No. 81 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
