ORAL ORDER

4 11-04-2022 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and
the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Konch P.S. Case No. 131 of 2020 registered for the offence
punishable under section 307 and other allied sections of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners
submits that petitioners have not committed any offence as
alleged in the first information report and they have been
falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity. Both
sides are agnates and there is old land dispute between the

parties. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that petitioners are named accused in the first information report and there is direct allegation of assault against them which is supported by the injury report. Petitioners, therefore, do not deserve to be granted the privilege of bail.

Considering the nature of allegations levelled, the materials available on record and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. The same is, therefore, rejected.
