learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case registered in connection with Gopalpur P.S.Case No. 55 of 2016 for the offences punishable under Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 3/4 of the D.P.Act.

It is a case of cruelty due to non fulfillment of dowry of Rs. 2 lacs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that husband of the deceased was acquitted by the trial court on 23.01.2018. Petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased and she has no concern with the deceased and husband of the deceased.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the bail prayer of the petitioner.



Considering the facts and circumstance of the case as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court Below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VII, Patna in connection with Gopalpur P.S Case No. 55 of 2016 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C
