2 07-12-2022 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this writ application is being filed for issuance of an appropriate writ/wits in the nature of writ of Mandamus or any other writ, order or direction commanding upon the respondent nos. 2 to 7 to provide due protection to the petitioner for his life



and properties and oust the unlawful elements (the respondent nos. 8 to 11) who are creating disturbances and giving threat to the petitioner and his family members' peaceful possession in respect of his Bataidari land bearing Khata No. 20, Khesra No. 112, measuring an area of 41 decimal out of 2.48 dec. in Mouza Denwara, P.S. and Anchal Dhoraiya, District-Banka."

This Court finds that the remedy of the petitioner lies elsewhere, hence, in case, the petitioner is having any subsisting grievance, he may take recourse to such other remedies as are otherwise available under the law.

With the aforesaid observation and liberty to the petitioner, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
