Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Barbigha P.S. Case No. 57/2022, registered for the offences under Section 30(a)/52 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Considering the prosecution case and the fact that the petitioner was not caught of the spot, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount



each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-II, Sheikhpura, in connection with Barbigha P.S. Case No. 57/2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
