4 14-12-2022 In pursuance to the earlier order of this Court dated 28.09.2022, a counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of respondent no. 2, wherein, it has been stated that the final order under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 has already been passed by the Circle Officer, Bhargama,



Araria, in connection with Encroachment case no. 01 of 2021-22, which is annexed as Annexure-B to the said counter affidavit.
