3 30-06-2022 Though, the present writ petition was filed for grant of ex-gratia compensation amount to the petitioner in lieu of death of her husband on account of Covid-19 infection, but during the interregnum period, the Respondent State has acted in a benevolent manner and taken steps to grant ex-gratia compensation to the tune of Rs. 4.5 lacs to the petitioner, which is not denied by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and he submits that as a consequence of grant of ex-gratia payment, the



present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of as not pressed, however, with an appreciation for the conduct of the respondent State.
