2 27-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 304(B), 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of dowry death. Petitioner is cousin father-in-law of the deceased.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that thrust of the accusation is against husband of the deceased, who is already in custody. Petitioner is victim of over implication. Petitioner is separate in mess & property and has got no concern with the family affairs of deceased and her husband. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

However, learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail petition.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Begusarai in connection with Mansoorchak P.S. Case No. 80 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure
