2 10-10-2022 Though the present writ petition was filed for removal of encroachment from the public road situated in front of the land of the petitioner, appertaining to Khata No. 615, Plot No. 6267, situated at Khakhari Tola of Kashichak Circle, however, the respondent have filed a counter affidavit and have submitted that the respondent no. 5 i.e. the Circle Officer, Kashi Chak, Nawada, has already initiated an encroachment proceeding



bearing Encroachment Case No. 01/2020-2021.

In such view of the matter, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the respondent no. 5 for expeditious disposal of the same.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off with a direction to the respondent no. 5 to conclude and dispose off the aforesaid Encroachment Case No. 01/2020-2021, in accordance with law and after hearing the affected parties, within a period of 12 weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
