4 17-01-2022 The matter has been listed today for consideration through virtual mode.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

Let the defect(s) be removed within two weeks of the complete start of the physical Court in normal course.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submit that due to incorrect information given by the Pairvikar of the present case he has not given correct information regarding the criminal antecedent of petitioner no.1, in such circumstances he seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioners, however, submits that by filing supplementary affidavit he has brought on record the criminal antecedent of the petitioner no.1, and submits that no false statement has been made deliberately by him. He has only made statement in paragraph no.3 of the main application as per the instruction received by him.

Accordingly this criminal miscellaneous case stands dismissed as withdrawn. Petitioner if so advised, may file fresh application for bail.
